Summer coming? Let's tour a dam!

Our Past President, John Sawyers, has made arrangements for us to tour the City of Spokane's Upriver Dam. Originally built in 1894 as a wooden structure, it was replaced with a concrete one in 1933 and then significantly upgraded in the 1980s. Some of the power generated is used to pump water to the City's water system, with the remaining sold to Avista to power around 4,405 households.



Take Waterworks Avenue northeast off of Trent Avenue near the Western States CAT facility. Continue up Waterworks and follow the signs for the Upriver Interpretive Center. Lunch will be a selection of Subway sandwiches, chips, and drinks at the nearby gazebo. For this event, we're once again offering a \$10 lunch for all with encouragement to bring fellow engineers, regardless of ASCE member status. Weather is always an unknown, so be prepared to dress appropriately and **bring your hard hat and high-vis vest.**
